Descrizione Description:	<p><i>Since the beginning of my PhD in 2013, my research activities have focused on four main research areas: Fiscal Policies, Innovation, Monetary Policy, and Ecological Economics. During the last 7 years, I have published 44 research outputs, of which 29 papers in top-ranked journals (ASN-Fascia A), 12 in other peer-reviewed journals (non-ranked as Fascia A), 2 book chapters, and 2 entries in encyclopedia. Among the 45 research outputs, only 1 paper was co-authored with my PhD supervisor. My papers have been published in high IF peer-reviewed international journals, such as Oxford Economic Papers, Research Policy, Industrial and Corporate Change, Technological Forecasting and Social Change, Energy Policy, Macroeconomic Dynamics, Economic Modelling, Regional Studies, Structural Change and Economic Dynamics, and Socio-Economic Planning Sciences. My studies impact the scientific economic community as testified by the number of citations recorded through Google Scholar (8 May 2025, Total citations: 1351; H-index: 21; i10-index: 27) https://scholar.google.com/citations?user=na0a1DcAAA&hl=it. In addition, some of my studies on green investment, and fiscal, monetary, and innovation policies impacted the society and policymaking institutions. In 2019, a policy report titled 'The Macroeconomic Impact of Government Innovation Policies' (R&R on The Economic Journal) was prepared for Innovate UK and presented at the UK Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS) during an IIPP-BEIS workshop on 'Mission-Oriented Industrial Strategy'; a report entitled 'Il ruolo dell'innovazione e dell'alta tecnologia in Italia' prepared for Centro Economia Digitale was cited by Sole24; the paper 'Fiscal Compact, quali sono gli effetti macroeconomici' on Economia e Politica was cited by Il Fatto Quotidiano. In 2017, I wrote a policy brief in response to the Treasury Select Committee inquiry of the UK parliament on 'The effectiveness and impact of post-2008 UK monetary policy'. <p>Descrizione Description:</p>	<p><i>I am an Associate Professor of Economics at the University of Bari (UniBa) and Co-PI on two research projects. The DEMETRA project, funded by PRIN-2022-PNRR (€119,633.00), and the SEED Project, funded by the Hans-Böckler Foundation (€142,200.00), evaluate the impact of green policies on transitioning to a sustainable economic system. I also serve as a member of the Board of Lecturers for the PhD program in Economics at Roma Tre University. Until May 2024, I was an Honorary Research Fellow at University College London (IIPP-UCL), where I coordinated the research area 'Money, Credit, and the Macroeconomy.' At IIPP-UCL, I worked as Co-PI with Prof. Mazzucato on 'The Macroeconomic Implications of Innovation Policies', a project conducted with Roma Tre University. This research examined the macroeconomic effects of mission-oriented innovation policies (MOIPs) and public investment in innovation. Before joining UniBa, I was a BE-FOR-ERC Fellow at the Sapienza University of Rome where I coordinated a project on the macroeconomic implications of MOIPs funded by the SAPIExcellence Programme with a €50,000.00 grant. Before then, I was a research fellow in macroeconomics at Parthenope University of Napoli and Roma Tre University, where I co-led the CRUI "Go for IT" project. In February 2017, I was appointed as a Research Fellow in Finance and Innovation at IIPP-UCL, where I participated with Prof. Mazzucato in an H2020 project to study the determinants of long-term investments. During that period, I also developed a strong background in innovation theory, fiscal policy, and econometrics by working as Co-PI on a project on MOIPs, which was awarded £118,477.00 by Innovate UK.
