Descrizione Description:	<p><i>I am a statistician and demographer by training, with a particular interest in advanced statistical methods for longitudinal data analysis to better understand the social and demographic determinants of health in older populations. As a statistician, I bring methodological expertise to programmes in which I work, making significant contributions to grant applications and publications by providing my methodological skills in applied statistics to better understand population health. I also lead a programme of research that investigates the complex dynamics between intergenerational relationships and social engagement (including paid work, volunteering, and provision of informal care) and mental and physical health in mid and later life using large longitudinal datasets and advanced statistical methodologies. I have developed a battery of bespoke questions on grandparenting for the English Longitudinal Study of Ageing (since Wave 8 in 2016/17) and the "Happy Grandparents?" survey in Italy (2016), thereby shaping the research agenda. Also, I have been invited to join national and international networks of researchers dealing with intergenerational relationships, informal care provision, and health in later life in Europe. With the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, I further broadened my research to study sociodemographic inequalities in health, particularly among older people and those with underlying health conditions who faced a higher risk of developing severe illness. Throughout my career, I have demonstrated the ability to sustain my own research and to be successful in research competition in ways appropriate to my discipline. I have also attached great importance to scientific partnerships and have collaborated extensively with colleagues from academia as well as non-academic partners including NGOs (GrandparentsPlus, Carers UK, Centre for Ageing Better), independent research organisations (Pensions Policy Institute), and policymakers (UK Departments for Work and Pensions and of Health and Social Care). My research excellence and commitment are further reflected in my strong record of national and international conference</i></p>

Moreover, my expertise is highly valued by the scientific community, where I serve as a peer reviewer for funding bodies (including the European Commission and National Research Institutes) and international peer-reviewed journals.
