Descrizione Description:	<i>Over the last ten years of research I have dedicated a lot of energy to the study of the renewal of mental health services and Clinical Psychology interventions through the involvement of former users of the service, in the role of experts by experience. Italy is among the last European nations to consider the relevance of the collaborative approach in the co-design of services and to implement experts by experience, despite the fact that all this is already an integral part of many documents and guidelines promoted by the WHO. The interest in the evolution of the role of the patient along the recovery path has allowed me to compose a research group through funding from the Ministry of Health, which has dedicated itself to this important issue, in network with other European countries (Joint-Action - "Mentor" project). I had the opportunity to study in depth the personal path of identity change necessary in order to support the transition from a former user of a mental health service to that of</i>
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	a collaborator of the service itself. In fact, I was involved in the evaluation of the effectiveness of the first training course activated in Italy (again thanks to a contribution from the Ministry of Health) to become experts by experience, activated in Bologna in 2023. This long journey has allowed me to gain some visibility on the topic and to enter the networks of professionals/researchers who deal with this topic both in Italy and abroad. I am a member of the Technical-Scientific Committee that seeks to support the newly-formed Italian Association of Experts by Experience (Aipesp) in the process of recognition of the role at the Ministry of Labour. The group I am leading is engaged in mapping the experiences of ESP implementation at European level and participates in research on international formations oriented towards the acquisition of the ESP title. We are very attentive to the investigation of power dynamics in the therapeutic relationship and pursue objectives of fairness and protection of the rights of the ex-user. We are extending the collaborative approach to clinical contexts of various kinds, such as substance addiction, eating disorders, and gender transitions. All ten articles submitted were published in Q1 journals under their first or last names. They relate to the following questions: 1. The co-production of mental health services 2. Clinical intervention related to identity or gender issues 3. Clinical intervention in eating disorders.

Descrizione Description:	<i>The research group I co-ordinated has undertaken several initiatives to enhance the knowledge gathered through research and training on the topic of co-production in mental health services. It has made several trips to compare methodologies and research results within the collaborative approach in Germany, Latvia, the U.K. but also in Italy (Caserta, Naples, Modelna, Bologna). Collaborative networks and testimonies on strategies that enable the implementation of experts by experience in a climate of role equity between users and professionals have expanded. We are fully aware that services must also be prepared to welcome this new figure. Training is needed to involve the entire system of practitioners, including those who use their services. We have forged a strong partnership with the Ministry of Health, in the person of Dr Giuseppe Salamina, which has enabled us to expand the contexts of research and to make the first attempts to involve experts by experience also in collaborative research processes within the services themselves.</i>
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Descrizione Description:	Scientific dissemination meetings and events: 15/01/2025 - Participation as speakers in the periodic online meeting of "Rights to Madness", dedicated to the current state of services in relation to the inclusion of ESPs. The event saw the participation of Dr. Elena Faccio, Dr. Ludovica Aquili and Dr. Michele Rocelli as speakers. The presentation addressed central themes such as the critical issues related to the inclusion of ESPs, epistemic injustice and the transformative value of recovery stories and the telling of one's own experience. Research and theoretical reflections developed in the previous
